2026/2027 Skating Season

Guest Coach Policy

Guest Coaches are defined as a coach who is not under contract with the Tri Area Skating Club.

All Programming (Fall/ Winter/ Spring/ Boot Breaker)

- Guest Coaches/ Skaters must be approved by the Club Director and Head Coach
- Guest Coaches must be in good standing with Skate Canada and show proof of good standing prior to being on the ice
- Guest Coaches are not able to coach members of the Tri Area Skating Club unless specific approval has been given (such as a choreographer, dance partner, technical specialist)
- Guest Coaches are only allowed to coach their guest skater
- Guest Coaches/ Skaters are only allowed on ice time that corresponds to the skater's level and is not at maximum capacity with Tri Area Skating Club Members.
- Guest skaters must be registered Skate Canada Members

Rates

Guest skaters must prepay for their sessions at \$25/ hour

Guest skaters are exempt from fundraising

The Tri Area Skating Club has the right to cancel an agreement with a guest coach at any point in time during the regular or off season.
