Make Up Ice Policy

2024/2025 Skating Season

Make Up Ice Policy

- 1. If a skater has to miss a scheduled ice session that has been previously purchased and registered for, they can do a make up class on another day during that calendar month.
- 2. Missed days can not be banked and applied to future programming, ie. Spring session
- 3. The make up session can not be at its maximum number allocation. (25 for Junior, 20 for intermediate and senior, 20 for mixed levels)
- 4. Coaches need to be notified of any changes for lesson planning
- 5. This policy includes on ice sessions, off-ice classes, and group enrichment classes
- 6. The Tri Area Skating Club is not responsible to provide refunds for mixed sessions and are not obligated to provide make-up ice. This policy is intended as a tool for skaters to make up for mixed sessions.
- 7. The policy is meant for temporary/ short term absence mostly due to illness or mild injury

No Show Lessons

- 1. No Show Lessons are booked times where skaters do not attend the session with no notice to the coaching team
- 2. No Show Lessons will be invoiced as if the skater had attended the lesson
- 3. If skaters No Show, they are not included in the Make Up Ice Policy
